InsperaScan: For Part II you are meant to answer on handwritten sheets. Part I must be answered directly in Inspera. At the bottom of the question you will find a seven-digit code. Fill in this code in the top left corner of the sheets you wish to submit. We recommend that you do this during the exam. If you require access to the codes after the examination time ends, click "Show submission".

Weighting: Part I consists of 20 multiple choice questions. Each correct answer gives 2.5 points. Only one of the six alternatives is correct on each question. Answer all the questions, also if you do not know the correct answer. (Minus points are NOT awarded.)

In Part II, the weights are given for each of the 8 partial questions.

Part I and Part II each counts for 50% of the exam.

Notifications: If there is a need to send a message to the candidates during the exam (e.g. if there is an error in the question set), this will be done by sending a notification in Inspera. A dialogue box will appear. You can re-read the notification by clicking the bell icon in the top right-hand corner of the screen.
